



# MASK UP, MICHIGAN

## as we head back to school!

Research shows masks can reduce the chance of spreading COVID-19 by up to **70 percent**, which is especially important when approximately 40 percent of those who have the virus may be asymptomatic.

### Face coverings must be worn during school\*:

In classrooms\*\*, on school buses, in hallways and common areas in school buildings, except during meals.

Homemade face coverings must be washed daily. Disposable face covering must be disposed of at the end of each day.

*\*A student unable to medically tolerate a face covering should not wear one. Any student who is incapacitated or unable to remove a face covering without assistance must not wear one.*

*\*\*Unless students in grades K through 5 remain in their classroom throughout the day and do not come into close contact with other classrooms. Masks are still strongly encouraged.*
